In 2007 no TC39 face-to-face meetings were held.

However, TG1 was very active, and has met under **Mr. Eich** almost monthly in (**Mr. Neumann** attended their last meeting in November 2007 and reported to the GA on his impressions). In addition weekly teleconferences were held both with Ecma members' and invited experts' participation. ECMA-262 4th edition is delayed and hopefully it will be ready for GA vote for December 2008.

TC39-TG2, TG3 and TG5 are not active.

However, TC39-TG4 is very active in creating new version of Eiffel Language standard.
