Note that parking is scarce after about 10:30am, so allow extra time to find parking. Meet in the lobby of building 42, which is in the southwest corner of the four-building complex on the satellite image; enter at the driveway at the intersection of Charleston and Alta streets.

The closest domestic airport is SJC, which 12 miles away. The closest international airport is SFO, which is 23 miles away. Good nearby hotels are available in Mountain View, Sunnyvale, Palo Alto, or, if you rent a car and prefer a more urban but faraway environment, San Francisco. There are no hotels within walking distance of the Google campus.
